Simone Ek is a leading authority on the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. She holds an M.D. in Political Science from Stockholm University and a post graduate degree in communication, marketing and opinion building. During 1980-89 she was External Relations Director of the Swedish *Save the Children International* in Geneva and active in the entire drafting of the Convention. Prior to that, she was also Director of Information and Fundraising with the Swedish *Save the Children* in Stockholm.

Simone Ek was in close cooperation with the Ministry for Foreign Affairs during the International Year of the Child. She was the Coordinator of the Swedish Parliament Network for the CRC and also chaired the NGO Networks on Human Rights and CRC, working as a lobbyist with the Swedish Government and Parliament as well as the European Parliament.

In June 2007 she launched the *Travaux Préparatoires, The Legislative History on the Convention on the Rights of the Child* in cooperation with the UN Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights in Geneva and Save the Children, Sweden; and later the Swedish popular version focusing on the role of the NGO's in the drafting of the CRC. *Travaux Preparatoires* consists of two volumes amounting to thousands of pages, and it contains the complete documents of the drafting of the Convention and will be of support for national legislator, teachers, universities, and research.
