<u>Ballet Basics</u> <i>For ages 5-8</i> The first class in the Prep Center's progressive Classical Ballet curriculum. Emphasis is placed upon building the foundation for a sound ballet technique through warm-up exercises and correct body alignment. Students learn how to work within the structure of traditional ballet classes. Learning and use of correct ballet terminology.	Saturday	10:45-11:30	\$545
<u>Intermediate Ballet</u> <i>For ages 8-12</i> 1-3 years of introductory ballet training required. Prerequisite: 2 years or more of Itty Bitty Ballet, Ballet Basics or Ballet A	Saturday	11:45-12:45	\$710
<u>Tap</u> <i>For age 5 and up</i> This class emphasizes basic tap steps and the fundamentals of rhythm, while exploring essential combinations and their importance to the art of tap dance.	Saturday	1:00-1:45	\$545
<u>Dance Combo</u> <i>For age 5 and up</i> A simultaneous introduction to ballet, jazz and tap.	Saturday	2:00-3:00	\$710
<u>Music Video Dance</u> <i>For age 6 and up</i> Students analyze and learn choreography combinations from various music videos, and film their performances for the final music video project.	Saturday	10:45-11:45	\$710
