<p><u>Introduction to Suzuki Violin</u> <i>For ages 3-6</i> Designed to be a child and parent's first experience with the violin and an introduction to the Suzuki method. The child is taught the correct way of holding the violin, the feet position, and the bow hold. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday	10:30-11:15	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Flute</u> <i>For age 7 and up</i> Students are introduced to basic techniques, simple melodies, note-reading, and playing with a small group of peers. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday	11:00-11:45	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Piano</u> <i>For age 5 and up</i> Students are introduced to the fundamentals of piano playing in a supportive group environment. Instruction will include note reading, piano technique, and learning simple pieces. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday Thursday	11:00-11:45 4:15-5:00	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Violin</u> <i>For age 5 and up</i> Students learn the correct way to hold the violin and bow, in addition to learning simple melodies and basic rhythms by utilizing a combination of imitation (learning by ear) and basic note reading. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday Thursday	11:15-12:00 4:00-4:45	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Cello</u> <i>For age 5 and up</i> Students begin by learning to hold the cello without hands, the feet position and the bow hold, in addition to learning simple melodies and basic rhythms by utilizing a combination of imitation and basic note reading. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday	11:00-11:45	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Guitar</u> <i>For age 5 and up</i> Students are introduced to basic techniques, including learning simple melodies and chord progressions in a relaxed student group. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday	10:45-11:30	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Drum Class</u> <i>For age 5 and up</i> Students learn the correct way to hold drumsticks, get introduced to various percussion instruments, read sheet music and tabs, and play rudiments. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday	11:30-12:15	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Clarinet</u> <i>For age 6 and up</i> Students are introduced to basic techniques, simple melodies, note-reading, and playing with a small group of peers. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday	11:00-11:45	\$210
<p><u>Introduction to the Trumpet</u> <i>For age 8 and up</i> Students are introduced to basic techniques, simple melodies, note-reading, and playing with a small group of peers. Maximum of 3 students per section.</p>	Saturday	11:00-11:45	\$210

Creative Dramatics for the Very Young <i>For ages 4 to 7</i> Using the child's imagination and creativity, this class uses theater games, movement and song to introduce acting, creating an environment for young children to develop and perform social and communication skills.	Saturday 1:00-1:45	\$175
Musical Theater and Improv <i>For age 7 and up</i> Emphasis is placed on developing technique and stage presence through story dramatization, improvisation, and movement in this workshop. Students learn song-and-dance combinations for the end-of-year virtual performance.	Saturday 1:30-2:45	\$255

DANCE CLASSES

Course Title	Day/Time	Tuition
Ballet Basics <i>For ages 5-8</i> The first class in the Prep Center's progressive Classical Ballet curriculum. Emphasis is placed upon building the foundation for a sound ballet technique through warm-up exercises and correct body alignment. Students learn the use of correct ballet terminology, and how to work within the structure of traditional ballet classes.	Saturday 10:45-11:30	\$175
Intermediate Ballet <i>For ages 8-12</i> 1-3 years of introductory ballet training required. Pre-requisite: 2 years or more of Itty Bitty Ballet, Ballet Basics or Ballet A	Saturday 11:45-12:45	\$205
Dance Combo <i>For age 5 and up</i> A simultaneous introduction to ballet, jazz and tap.	Saturday 2:00-3:00	\$205
Music Video Dance <i>For age 6 and up</i> Students analyze and learn choreography combinations from various music videos, and film their performances for the final music video project.	Saturday 11:30-12:30	\$205
Jump and Move <i>For ages 4-7</i> Introduction to hip hop and jazz styles. This class focuses on developing students' sense of rhythm, balance, coordination and strength.	Saturday 10:30-11:15	\$175
Hip Hop <i>For age 8 and up</i> Students work on the individualized dance steps, combinations and improvisational elements that make up urban dance.	Saturday 3:00-4:00	\$205

Itty-Bitty Ballet: leotard, tights and ballet shoes (any color). Sweat pants, loose shirts and ballet shoes also accepted. **All other Ballet classes:** black or pink leotards, black or pink tights, and leather ballet shoes. Skirts are optional. (Oversized clothing and jewelry are not permitted.)

Combo Classes, Jump & Move, Hip-Hop, Tap: comfortable clothing, sneakers (Jump & Move and Hip-Hop Classes), tap shoes (Tap Class) and ballet & tap shoes (Dance Combo). **Contemporary Dance:** all-black leotards, footless tights, leggings, shorts, t-shirts or tanks. Bare feet.
