

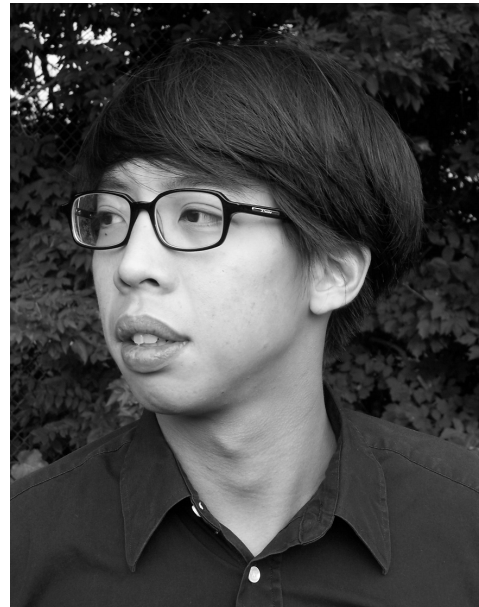

**Celina Su's** first book of poetry, *Landia*, was published by Belladonna\* in 2018. Her writing includes two poetry chapbooks, three books on the politics of social policy and civil society, and pieces in journals such as *n+1*, *Harper's*, and *Boston Review*. Su is the Marilyn J. Gittell Chair in Urban Studies and a Professor of Political Science at the City University of New York. She was born in São Paulo, Brazil, and lives in Brooklyn.

**Rattawut Lapcharoensap** is the author of *Sightseeing* (Grove Atlantic), a collection of short stories, which received the Asian American Literary Award and was shortlisted for the Guardian First Book Award. His work has appeared in *Granta*, *One Story*, *The Guardian*, *Zoetrope*, *Best New American Voices*, and *Best American Non-Required Reading*, among others. He is a recipient of a Whiting Writer's Award, a DAAD fellowship, a National Book Foundation 5 Under 35 honor, an Abraham Woursell Prize through the University of Vienna, and was named by *Granta* magazine on its list of "Best of Young American Novelists."
