

Council on Academic Accreditation – Notice of Public Meeting

The Doctor of Audiology (Au.D.) education program in audiology (residential) at Graduate Center of the City University of New York is scheduled for its periodic CAA reaccreditation review, with site visitation conducted on an eight-year cycle. Site visitors are scheduled for a visit to assess the program's conformity with the standards of accreditation on Thursday, March 30 and Friday, March 31, 2023.

As a part of the reaccreditation review, we are asked to solicit public comment from students and consumers by arranging a "Public Meeting" for the site visitors to meet a representative sample of program stakeholders.
