

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
for  
ADMISSIONS EARLY ASSURANCE PROGRAM  
Between  
NEW YORK INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY  
COLLEGE OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE  
and  
CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEWYORK BROOKLYN COLLEGE

I. PURPOSE

This document is an articulation agreement between the New York Institute of Technology (NYIT) College of Osteopathic Medicine and City University of New York/ Brooklyn College (CUNY/Brooklyn) of an Osteopathic Medicine Admissions Early Assurance Program. The Admissions Early Assurance Program is an admissions program for exceptional candidates with outstanding college records and correspondingly high MCAT scores to NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine.

II. ADMISSIONS

To be eligible for this early action program the applicant must have completed the first two years of the four year undergraduate program at CUNY/Brooklyn College and meet the following criteria:

- Overall and science grade point averages of 3.3 at CUNY/Brooklyn College
- A favorable recommendation by the Premedical Committee

In addition, to continue enrollment in the program and be accepted to NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine, the student must meet the following criteria:

- Maintain the overall and science grade point average of 3.3
- An MCAT score of at least equal to or higher of the average MCAT score of NYIT/COM first year class corresponding to the entry year of undergraduate study.
- Completion of a minimum of 8 hours of biology (course/lab), 8 hours each of inorganic and organic chemistry (course/lab), 8 hours of physics (course/lab), and 6 hours of English, with no grade below B in any of these courses and labs. Additional courses

may be recommended by CUNY/Brooklyn Premedical Committee to be in line with the MCAT 2015 examination.

- Passing a personal interview by NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine faculty

Students enrolled in this program who do not meet or exceed the above standards have the privilege of applying for admission to NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine through the regular channels or procedures. NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine reserves the right to deny admission to students who, in the opinion of NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine, may have difficulty obtaining a medical license.

Early Assurance Deadlines

Application deadline-May 1 following the student's sophomore year  
Completion of the applicant's file-June 1 following the student's junior year.

III. CANCELLATION

Either party to this agreement may cancel by formal notification to be received by October 1st in the year preceding the date of cancellation. All students who are enrolled in the program at the time of such notification shall be continued in the program and shall be eligible for acceptance by NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine under the terms of the agreement.
