- 2. A vote to approve the minutes of the 12/16/2020 meeting was unanimous
- 3. President Anderson updates Policy Council the Board of Trustees decided against implementing the Credit/No Credit policy across CUNY. Instead, campuses should refer to their respective pass/fail options. Faculty Council committees are considering the policy and ask student government for suggestions.
